### 2. Parent-teacher interviews

On parent-teacher night, you will be able to:

- Seek advice from your teachers about subjects on offer;
- Receive a personal subject selection sheet with a code for access to the subject selection survey.



Students who do not attend parent-teacher interviews must collect their code from their Deputy Principal the following day.



## 3. Elective survey

The elective survey requires you to:

- Select 3 preferred electives from most desired to least desired;
- Select reserve electives in case you cannot be placed in a preferred course.



## 4. Return your survey

To complete your subject selections, you must:

- Submit your survey online by the due date;
- Complete a handwritten copy of your preferred subjects to your Deputy Principal's office. This must be signed by you and a parent or carer.

Your online survey must match the information written on your signed sheet.



### 5. School review of elective data

The school will:

- Analyse your course preferences;
- Interview students as needed;
- Generate elective lines and classes;
- Provide you with your subjects later this year.

You may not receive all subjects you have requested.





Tonight night, you will receive a sheet with information about the elective survey.

### It will include:

- Your name and program;
- The URL for the survey;
- Your unique webcode.


- 1. Read the Stage 5 Curriculum Handbook 2025-2026 carefully.

#### Your Webcode is: **DELI25**


Students in the Talented Sports Program will see a form that specifically includes their sport. If you are directed to the wrong form, see Mr Deli in the English staffroom as soon as possible.

- 7. Return the hard copy to the box outside your supervising Deputy Principal's office by Friday 26 July (Term 3, Week 1).





