I would like to pay particular mention to Brett who's contribution to the running of the Athletics Program at Westfields is both invaluable and irreplaceable. Also special mention to our own Dani Stevens whose commitment and dedication to our club over 20 years is unsurpassed. To have the greatest ever female discus thrower as a proud member of our club is something that few clubs can appreciate. Dani is always available to attend and support our activities, and only ever gives her apologies when she is representing her country oversees and is unavailable.

COVID has taken its toll on NSW Registered clubs and their ability to provide grants to local clubs such as ours. Generally speaking about 75% of the NSW Registered Clubs had to put a hold on all funding this year. However, there was one club that refused to abandon us. For the 19th year in a row Club Liverpool (formerly the John Edmonson VC Memorial Club) has come to the party and continued to support us with their annual donation of \$4000, bringing their total donations over the years to \$76,000.00. To all the board members of Club Liverpool please accept the thanks of the entire Westfields Family.

Unable to hold our annual Trivia night this year where Sharyn Dickson manages to raise almost \$5000 dollars and our Shopping tour organised by Janet Stickler, I was extremely concerned and sent out an SOS to our parents. I was hoping to raise a thousand dollars and asked parents if they would help out and make donations of \$100 towards helping sponsor individual awards. I am very proud to announce that the parents donated over \$2000. Those generous families were the Nadaya-Harb family, the Alizart family, the Goetz family, the Banovich family, the Hunter family, the Stickler family and a very generous donation of \$1000 from the Cassilles family's company Cassilles Joinery. Continuing their sponsorship this year as well are firstly Steve Want owner of the Sportsfactory. In this current climate where most organisations order their sporting apparel from overseas suppliers it is refreshing to note the Sportsfactory continue to supply its clothing as an Australian Product where the majority of their clothing items are produced here in Sydney employing Australian workers. David and Karin Suchy each year continue to donate a substantial amount towards the athletes awards and for that we are once again grateful.

Last but not least are Rosemary and Wilf Mula who set up the Adhemar Ferreira da Silva Scholarship back in 2003. This marks the 18th year the Scholarship will be awarded. It is difficult to state exactly how much they have contributed however my estimate is in excess of \$60,000.00. We will hear from Rosemary shortly as she announces this year's winner who will receive the Adhemar trophy, \$1000

prizemoney and an all-expenses paid interstate trip for athlete and coach to the Interstate athletics meet of their choice.

A new award (called National level athlete) was added this year to recognise those athletes who would have competed at National Level (qualified for the Australian Championships) however were unable to do so with its cancellation. Impressively we had 21 athletes who were about to compete at the 2020 Nationals when COVID restrictions cancelled the Championships.

Life membership is awarded to athletes who have given a minimum of 10 years of service to Westfields. 2020 represents the 10th year of service of one of our most popular and dedicated athletes. It gives me great pleasure to award life membership to Bailey Woodward.
